### **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FIRST DAY:-**

**Things to be brought and deposited on 25.3.2020**

1. **Admission Slip** - The child will not be permitted into the new class without the original admission slip.
2. **Personal Proforma** - duly filled
3. **Medical Card** - duly filled with the child's photograph, doctor's signature, stamp and photocopy of immunization record.
4. **Consent form for the midday meal** - duly filled.

### **IDENTITY CARD/ESCORT CARD:**

**IDENTITY CARD-** To be worn by the child every day.

**ESCORT CARD-** To be carried by the person picking up the child.

Temporary identity cards and escort card will be given on the first day of school i.e. 25.3.2020. You are requested to fill all details including parents' name and address with telephone numbers of both office and residence. In case your child goes to a crèche, please write the address of the crèche clearly on the card.

### **NOTE:**

- **Recent photograph** of the person picking up the child must be pasted on the escort card/identity card. Parents' photograph is mandatory on the escort card as well as identity card.
- We request you to avoid changing the escorts for the safety and security of the children.

Tiffin box, water bottle, napkin, extra set of clothes and school diary should be brought to school every day. All belongings of the child must be labelled with a permanent marker clearly.

The security of your child is our prime concern. It is not advisable to use private vans, RTVs, open rickshaws etc. as mode of transport for your ward. If your child is using a rickshaw, kindly ensure that the rickshaw has a steel covered body and carries a maximum of only six children in it.

**Any change of telephone number, address, crèche, driver, rickshaw etc. should be informed to the class teacher immediately.**

Kindly ensure that the specific ribbon is pinned on the uniform of your child for the month of April and May. For easy identification, the class will have a colour code on the door and the class teacher will also wear the same coloured ribbon.

### **UNIFORM/BOOKS**

Uniform/books will be available in the Senior Wing of the School on 7.3.2020 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm. For the convenience of parents and students the Society for Education has facilitated a book and uniform store in the school premises. The use of the store is at the discretion of the parents and not mandatory or obligatory. However, parents/students must ensure that the books and uniforms used adhere to the prescribed books and uniform pattern.

### **MIDDAY MEAL (optional)**

The school plans to provide midday meal to the children of class Nursery. This will be in accordance to their dietary requirements. We aim to provide them with nutritious, balanced and hygienically prepared food. It will not only help in the balanced growth of the child but will also inculcate community spirit and a sense of oneness besides promoting healthy eating habits.
