SCHOOL EVENTS

REPORT ON VERICOMPOSTING

After three months of composting of leaves in the feeder bed, the partially decomposed leaves were shifted to vermi bed on 8th March 21. The leaves were then mixed with fresh cow dung to enhance the process of decomposition. Earthworms were also added to the vermi bed on 12th March 2021.



ORIENTATION FOR CLASS X AND XII PARENTS

An Orientation Programme was conducted for class X and XII parents on 26th March 2021. Around 220 parents, the Principal, Ms. Preeti Sangwan, the Coordinators, class teachers and subject teachers attended the Orientation regarding reopening of schools wef April 5, 2021. The parents were apprised of the reopening dates, the hybrid system (online and offline) for conducting classes for Class X, the dates when children will attend school and the dates for procuring uniforms and books.

Class XII parents were informed that classes will be online from 5th to 15th April 2021 and from 16th April 2021, they will be conducted Offline for four days and online for one day in a week.

The parents were shown a video regarding sanitization work in school through a video. Another video showcasing the work done throughout 2020-21 despite the pandemic was also shown. The parents were informed that no transport will be available in the month of April.

PTM

PTM for class X was held in the school to discuss the Pre-Board results on 20th March 2021. Parents were apprised about the conduct of improvement tests for Science, Maths and Social Studies in April.

A Virtual PTM of classes VI, VII, VIII, IX and XI for result discussion for the session 2020-21 was held through online mode on 27th March 2021. The report cards of all children were uploaded on the parent

portal earlier. Around 75% parents attended the PTM. The information about the online and offline days for the coming session- 2021-22 was shared with the parents.

MOCK HYBRID CLASS DEMONSTRATION

A simulation class was conducted by the coordinators of Classes IX and X on 31st March 2021, to find solutions to the challenges that might be faced by the teachers while conducting hybrid classes, which have been planned for the new session, commencing on 5th April 2021. The class teachers were made to sit in room no.10, representing offline students, while the subject teachers sat in room number 11, representing online students. A demonstration was given to show the proper placement of tripod and mobile phone so as to project the blackboard properly to the online students. In case of laptop, teachers were taught how to connect it to the projector so that the offline students can see the laptop screen on the smart board. The teachers found the session useful, as they felt more confident after the session to conduct the hybrid classes.



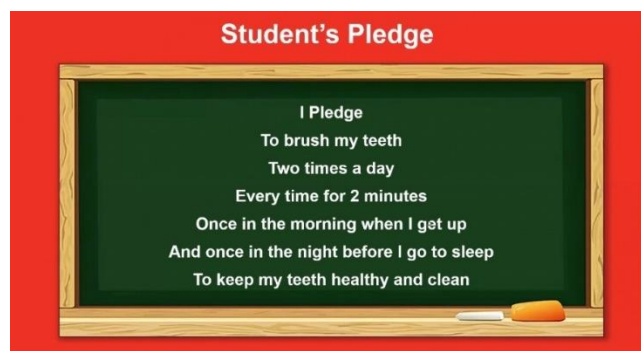
WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS FOR STUDENTS

ORAL CARE WEBINAR
